



INSURANCE:

Each vendor must provide proof of general liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 and submit a certificate of insurance prior to the market.

MARKET GOODS:

The following items are approved for sale:

Fresh fruits and vegetables if grown by the vendor.

Honey, maple syrup and value-added products, if prepared and packaged in accordance with the rules established by the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets (NYSDAM).

Trees, wreaths, potted plants, herbs, and dried flowers, if grown by the vendor.

Baked goods prepared in a licensed facility or with appropriate exemption from NYSDAM.

Meats and poultry must meet USDA **regulations**.

Fresh eggs packaged according to NYSDAM specifications.

Locally produced artisan crafts.

* Products not listed above must receive approval from the project advisory committee before sale.

MARKET POLICIES:

- All sellers agree to abide by fair business practices.
- Prices, terms of sale, etc. are solely between buyer and seller.
- All vendors must represent themselves appropriately (dress, cleanliness, etc.).
- All items must be prepared, displayed and stored in accordance with New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets, New York State Department of Health and any applicable local requirements.
- Vendors may not sell any items not approved or shown on their market application.
- All producers of processed items, (jams, jellies, breads, etc.) are required to adhere to labeling law requirements.
- All permits/licenses required by New York State are the sole responsibility of the vendor.
- Market vendors must be ready to start selling at 12p.m. on market day. Montgomery County Sundae on the Farm Committee encourages vendors to be ready 15 minutes before the event opens.
- Vendors are to remain setup until the end time of the event.
- Any required sales tax collections and remittances are the sole responsibility of the seller.
- Seller assumes full liability for the products they market or sell.
- No animals/pets in the market area except for service animals.
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages are to be consumed by the vendors during the market.
- Booth space to be determined by Project Coordinator.
